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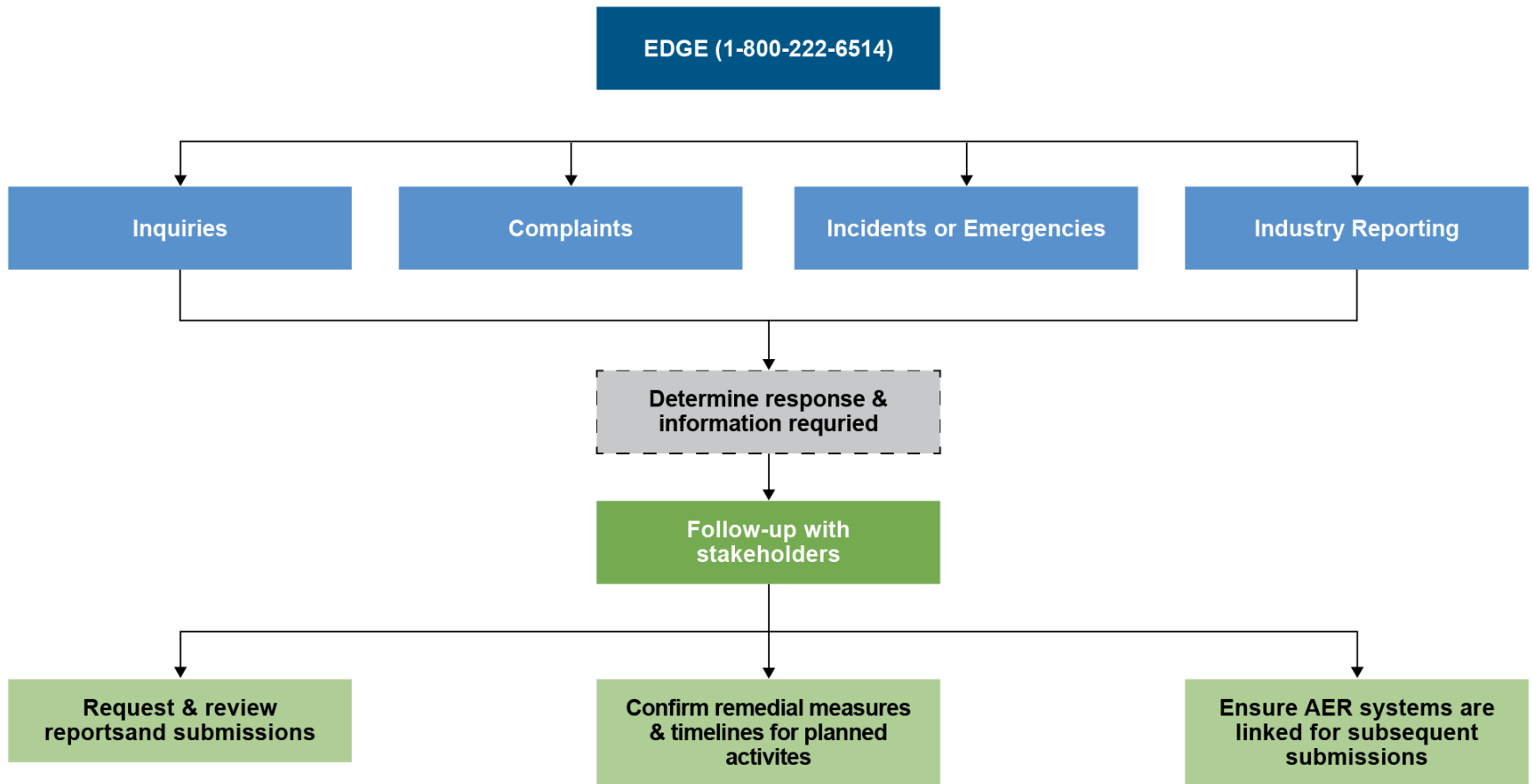

Updated Release Report: Highlights

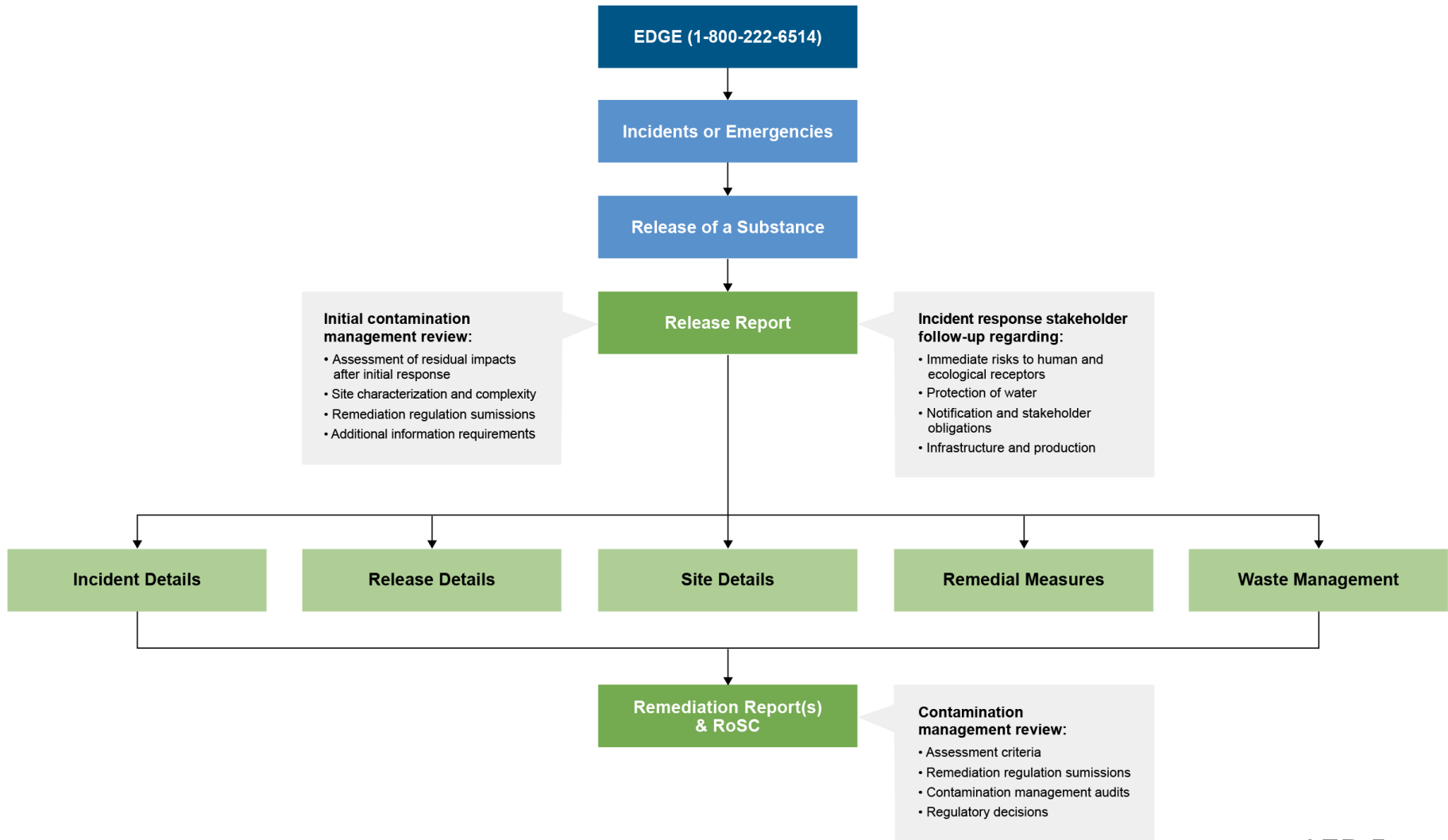
》 Content revised & re-formatted to:

- Support risk-informed approach
- Enhance integration with AER RoSC;
- Minimize duplication with parallel processes

》 New Efficiencies

- Responds to inputs
- Mass reporting for discoveries of historical contamination
- Tool tips built into the form

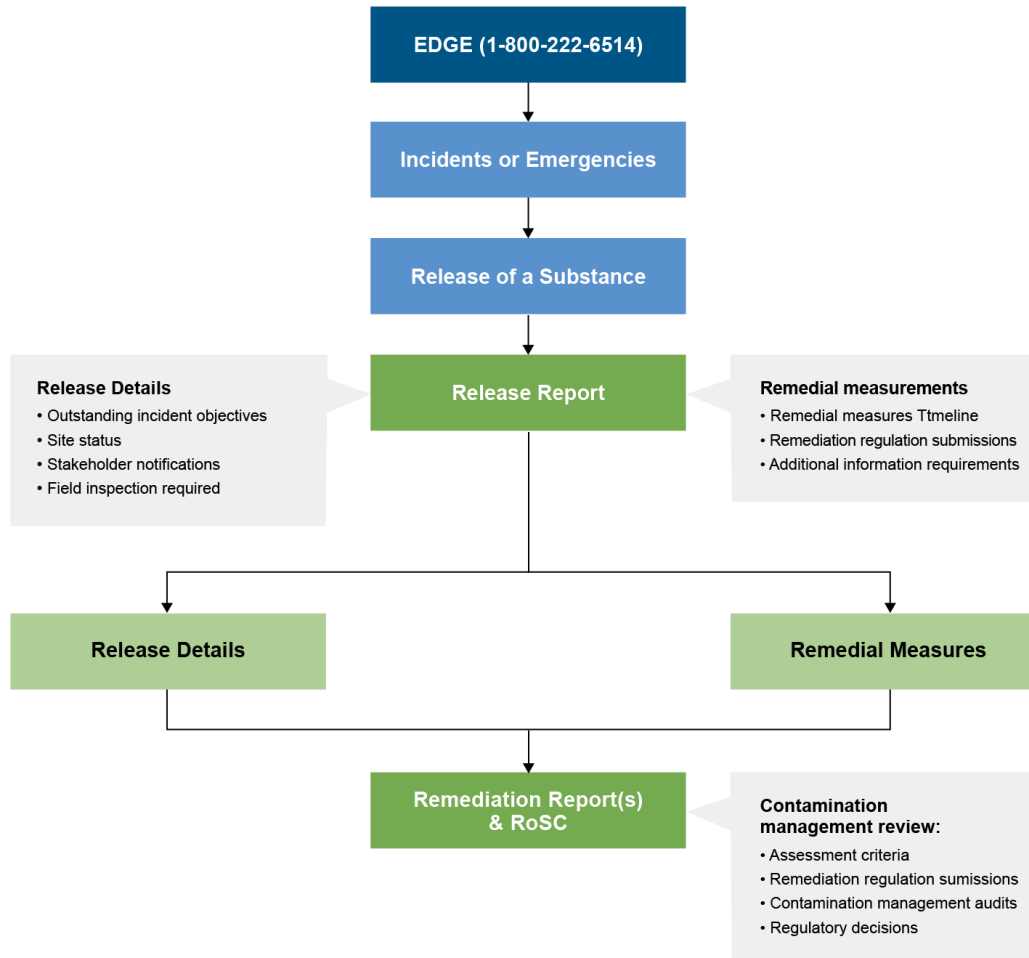
Release of a Substance



Discovery of Historical Contamination

- 》 Licensee must orally report to the AER at the first available opportunity for:
 - Any substance release that may cause or is causing an adverse effect
 - e.g. ESA Tier 1 Exceedances

Discovery of Historical Contamination *(Continued)*



Discovery of Historical Contamination *(Continued)*

Select all receptors potentially impacted:

- Wildlife Livestock Humans Property Surface water Groundwater
 Protected or threatened species habitat

Standard and Exception

Standard Process

- All start with EDGE

Exception: Pre-2019 Unreported Substance Releases

- www.aer.ca - “Pre-2019 Substance Releases”
- Pre-2019 RAP Tool with AER approval

Record of Site Condition

- 》 Tool used throughout life-cycle of contamination management
- 》 Collects site-specific information
- 》 Contains elements of a Remedial Action Plan

Record of Site Condition

》 In OneStop as of July 8, 2021

》 What's New:

- Intent of Submission
- OneStop terminology specific to RoSC

Intent of Submission

- 》 Identifies which legislative role the submission fulfills
 - What is the intent of submission, and
 - What submission best fulfills this intent

- 》 Establishes if the submission is:
 - Demonstrating compliance with the *Remediation Regulation*, or
 - Seeking regulatory acceptance

Intent of Submission *(Continued)*

Contamination Identification and Characterization

- Phase 2 ESA
- Groundwater Monitoring Report
- Soil Monitoring Report
- Groundwater Monitoring Update
- Surveillance Monitoring Report

Remedial Measures

- Remedial Action Plan (RAP)
- Risk Management Plan
- RoSC and Professional Report serving as a RAP
- Ongoing reporting of an accepted RAP
- Site-Specific Risk Assessment
- Decommissioning Report
- Remediation Confirmation Report

Regulatory or Administrative Closure of Contamination

- Application for a Tier 2 Compliance Letter
- Remediation Certificate Application
- Pre-Reclamation Certificate Application Contamination Review
- Reclamation Certificate

Intent of Submission *(Continued)*

- 》 Phase 2 ESA with remedial measures
 - Required within 2 years of becoming aware or ought to have become aware of a potential for adverse effect (*Remediation Regulation*)

- 》 For the AER to systematically recognize a RAP use either of these intents:
 - Remedial Action Plan under Remedial Measures
 - RoSC and Professional Report serving as a RAP under Remedial Measures

Accepted and Returned Statuses

Accept = Administratively complete,
Accepted into the system

- This does not mean “in compliance”
- This is **not** synonymous with regulatory acceptance.
- If Statutory Decision Made, Attachment indicates decision made.


Returned = Incomplete Submission

- e.g. ESA Standard not met, missing information
- Incorrect Intent (e.g. RAP but no RAP included)

TIP: Use Copy to Draft Function to re-submit

Questions with Common Errors

- » Related Entities: Enter ALL applicable
 - Licenses, FIS (All available now), EPEA, CSU etc.

Enter at least one of the following * 

CSU File Number	EPEA Approval Number	FIS Number	WM Approval Number	Asset	Pre-2019 RAP Submission	LLD Only
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- » Submission required by Letter of Direction or an Enforcement Order?
 - Inspector request for RoSC is neither

Questions with Common Errors

(Continued)

- 》 Does all analytical data collected on the site meet Tier 1?
- 》 Timing of the Reclamation Certificate Application submission
- 》 Indicate “Yes” if you already have an Accepted Remedial Action Plan

Does the site associated with the submission have a previously accepted remedial action plan? *

 Yes No

Does the submission contain a request to modify the previously accepted program or plan? *
